March 1	Application to CalState Apply	Apply to Cal Poly Humboldt as a Teaching Credential applicant online via Cal State Apply between October 1st and March 1st (Cost: \$70)
March 1	Letters of Recommendation	Two letters of recommendation from academic and/or professional references. Optional third letter is suggested.
June 1	Certificate of Clearance	Prior to being allowed into any classroom to complete observations, clinical practice, or student teaching, you must obtain a Certificate of Clearance* through the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC). This process can take <i>up to 6 weeks to complete</i> , so apply early!
		*It is not necessary to obtain a Certificate of Clearance if you can present a VALID California Certificate or Credential issued by the CTC such as an emergency sub permit, PIP, STSP, Children's Center Permit or Adult Vocational Education Credential

June 1	Subject Matter Competency	 There are a variety of ways to meet this requirement, please go to the <u>Subject Matter Competency</u> page on the CTC website for more detailed information: CSET exam (Multiple Subjects or Single Subject Area); between 2-4 subtests, they can be taken together or individually, valid for 10 years. Available at the Cal Poly Humboldt Testing Center, can take the exams as many times as necessary. CTC Approved Subject Matter Program Completion of a baccalaureate or higher degree in Subject Matter area Single Subject Credentials: a major in subject matter area of interest (confirm with School of Education that your major meets the requirement) Multiple Subject Credentials: a liberal studies major Successful completion of coursework from an institution of higher education that addresses each of the domains of the subject matter requirements adopted by the CTC.
